Femur fractures are classified depending on: The location of the fracture (the femoral shaft is divided into thirds: distal, middle, proximal) The pattern of the fracture (for example, the bone can break in different directions, such as crosswise, lengthwise, or in the middle)

Proximal femur fractures, or hip fractures, involve the uppermost portion of the thigh bone just adjacent to the hip joint. These fractures are further subdivided into: femoral neck fractures are those that occur when the ball of the ball-and-socket joint is broken at the top of the femur.

Proximal Femur. At the proximal end of the femur, the bulbous femoral head is joined to the shaft of the femur by the femoral neck. At the base of the neck are the medially oriented lesser trochanter and laterally placed greater trochanter. ... Spinal fractures are usually the result of significant trauma to a normally formed skeleton or the result of trauma to a weakened spinal column. Examples include: Jefferson fracture: ring fracture of C1; hangman fracture: bilateral pedicle or pars fracture of C2; dens fracture; flexion teardrop fracture: unstable flexion fracture; extension teardrop fracture: stable injury
