The manual recommends shining your lights at a wall 25' away, and adjusting for the high beam to be 2' below the height of the lamps. Wrong. You need to have the proper spring for your weight. From there you set the sag to about 100 mm from the top of the shock to sitting on the bike with full riding gear. I don't know about the 250, but the 300 suspension sucks in stock form. Both ends should be re-valved for best results on the trail.

When riding with heavy luggage or a passenger, there's plenty of preload adjustment available to set the correct ride height. A suspension upgrade is one of the best investments you can make in your KLR 650 and there is probably more room for improvement than on any other Adventure Bike.
