The Whole-word Approach teaches kids to read by sight and relies upon memorization via repeat exposure to the written form of a word paired with an image and an audio. The goal of the Language Experience Method is to teach children to read words that are meaningful to them.

3 Methods of teaching reading to children

Comprehension is, of course, the whole point of reading. As proficient readers read, they make meaning, learn new information, connect with characters, and enjoy the author's craft. But as students begin to transition in their skills from cracking the sound-symbol code to becoming active meaning makers, they do not always monitor their understanding of the text as they read or notice when they make errors.

Teaching Students to Read Metacognitively - Edutopia

Teach short, one-syllable words. Introduce your student to basic reading by showing them two or three letter, one-syllable words. Beginners tend to do best with words that have a consonant-vowel-consonant pattern, such as CAT or DOG. Start by asking the student to read a simple, one-syllable word such as "sit."

For early readers especially, multisensory instruction can help them grasp the fundamentals of literacy. Once children start reading picture books on their own, try to treat reading as a form of entertainment.
